

## COACH DRIVERS' CHARTER BORDEAUX CENTRE

In line with its new tourism strategy, Bordeaux Métropole is committed reducing the environmental impact of its events and tourist activity and preserving the quality of life in the city. This charter is intended to contribute to these aims.



## **NEW COACH PARK**

As of 1 September 2022, coach parking is restricted to a single site:

MetPark Allées de Bristol at
Quinconces (12 parking spaces).

Entry via Allées de Bristol from Quai Louis XVIII (see map in point n°1 below).

## **10 INSTRUCTIONS TO FOLLOW**

Please follow the <u>recommended</u> <u>routes</u> for coaches.



Switch engines and air conditioning off while parked. By switching off the engine for 1 hour, you reduce your carbon footprint by more than 1.6kg of CO2.

Do not park at passenger drop-off or pick-up points.



If your vehicle is equipped with passenger reading lights, please ensure that these lights are switched off during the daytime.



Comply with priority traffic flows for residents when dropping off or picking up passengers.



Ensure that passengers have access to empty bins on board to avoid littering outside.



In the event of an emergency evacuation, please remind passengers of safety instructions: direction and order of evacuation, behaviour, assembly point.



Check your tyre pressure regularly. Low pressure tyres increase fuel use and the risk of blow-outs.



Organise your schedule to avoid empty trips.



Maintain filters regularly (air, fuel, air-conditioning). Filters in poor condition can lead to additional fuel use.
